Parents choose a tutoring “provider” from a state-approved list. Providers may include districts, for-profits, community organizations, and faith-based organizations.

Districts contract with providers and develop an improvement plan for each student.

Districts must set aside between 5% and 15% of their Title I funds for SES.

USE OF FUNDS

- Tutoring and other research-based academic enrichment programs that supplement the instruction provided during the school day. Funds can be used for:
 - Instructor salaries
 - Instruction and assessment materials
 - Professional development
 - Use of physical facilities
- Instruction must occur outside of regular school hours

KEY POINTS

- **SES providers must demonstrate a record of effectiveness in increasing student achievement; provide services that are consistent with the district’s instructional program and the state’s standards; and use programs that are research-based.**
- **SES providers that fail to demonstrate academic improvements may risk losing their status as providers.**
- **SES providers are legally responsible for providing direct tutoring to the students.**
- **Any student who attends a qualifying school is eligible to enroll in SES; eligibility does not depend on the student’s academic performance.**
- **Districts may also use Title V, Part A funds to cover the cost of SES.**
