

# LESSON | A WHOLE WORLD OF CAREERS

Help students navigate possible occupations and apprenticeships with this fun research activity.

# **Objective**

Students will conduct research and analyze information to look for patterns, then collaboratively discuss their findings.

#### Time

45 minutes

# **Materials**

Find Your "Right Now"
 Job activity sheet



#### **Instructions**

Encourage students to identify potential careers. As a warm-up, ask them to share with a partner one or more careers that have sparked their interest and why.

**2** Distribute the Find Your "Right Now" Job activity sheet. Have students use the prompts to research criteria for teen jobs and apprenticeships related to their career interests.

3 Direct students to display completed research sheets around the classroom and give the class time to read several different job profiles. Organize a scavenger hunt by calling out certain criteria (e.g., strong written and verbal communication skills) and challenging students to find jobs and/or apprenticeships that match (e.g., speechwriter, marketing assistant).

Hold a class discussion guiding students to reflect on what they learned about the various careers, jobs, and apprenticeships they researched. Encourage them to elaborate on new discoveries they've made and actionable next steps to explore career pathways.

# **Suggested discussion prompts**

- Do you notice a pattern in the types of jobs that appeal to you? Describe it!
- Which job criterion applied to many different positions? Why do you think that is?
- Share one thing you learned from this activity that surprised you and why.

### **Increase the Challenge**

Direct students to turn research findings into infographics. (Use them in the scavenger hunt!)
