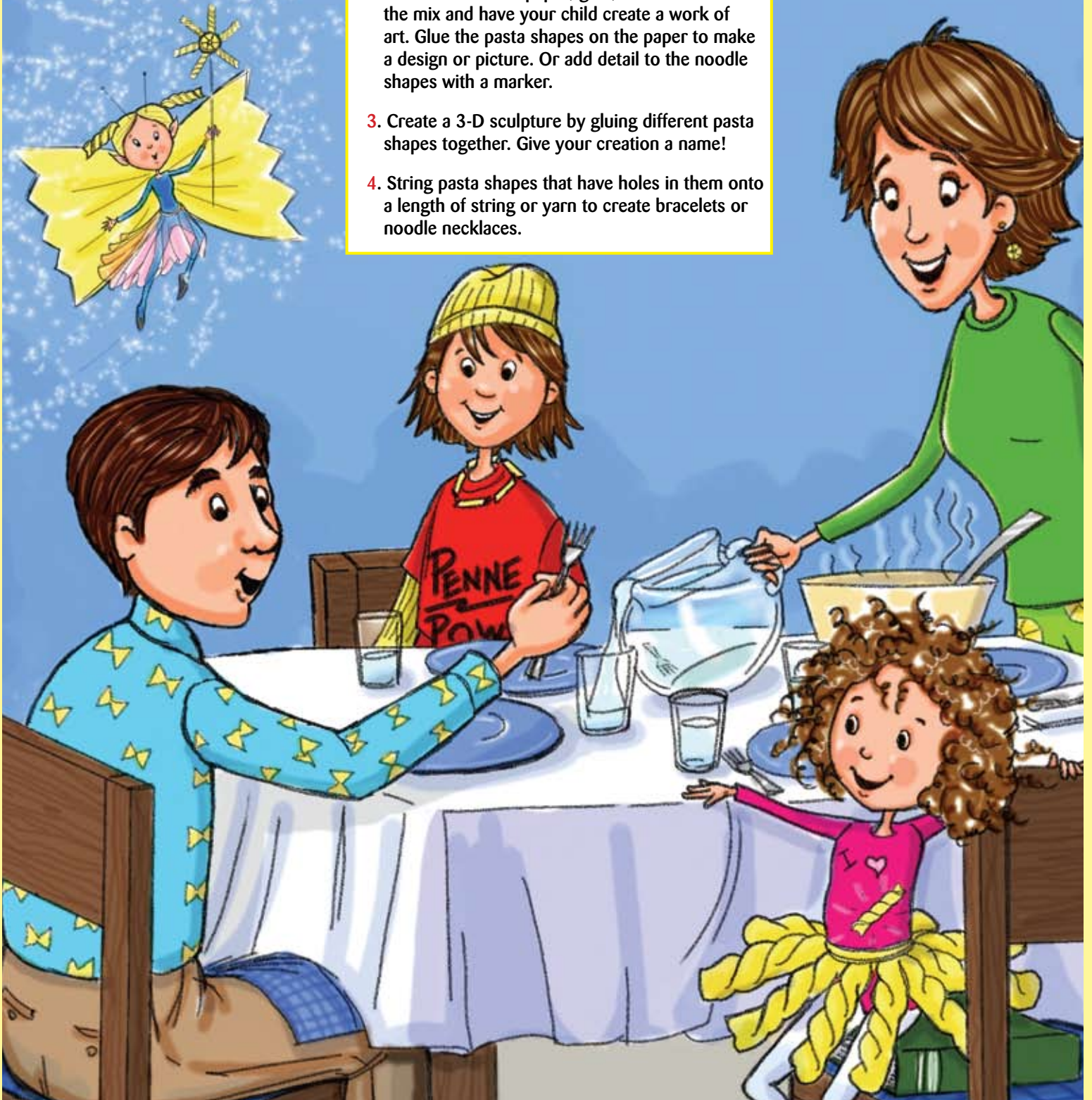


# Pasta Fun & Games

## Pasta Play!

1. Lay out different pasta shapes, measuring spoons, cups, and bowls. Have your child mix, measure, pour, and sort the shapes.
2. Add construction paper, glue, and markers to the mix and have your child create a work of art. Glue the pasta shapes on the paper to make a design or picture. Or add detail to the noodle shapes with a marker.
3. Create a 3-D sculpture by gluing different pasta shapes together. Give your creation a name!
4. String pasta shapes that have holes in them onto a length of string or yarn to create bracelets or noodle necklaces.
