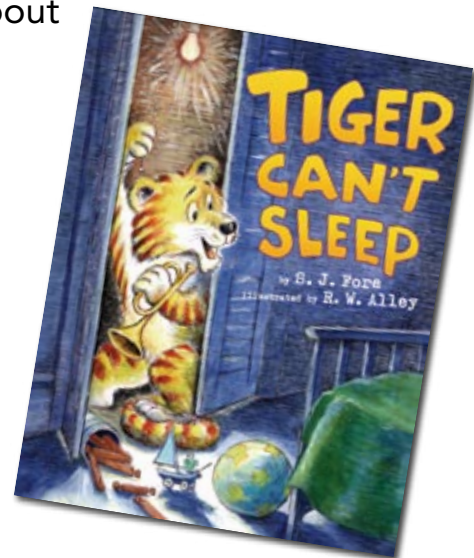
Tiger Can't Sleep
