

Papa Bear





Materials:

thick cardboard
various colors of poster paint
paintbrush
pencil
utility knife
bear pattern
one brass fastener

Directions:

1. Use pencil to trace bear pattern onto large piece of cardboard. (If you don't have cardboard big enough, use masking tape to tape two pieces together.)
2. Use a pencil to trace the bear's arm on a smaller piece of cardboard.
3. Cut out bear and his arm using a utility knife.
4. Make a small hole in the bears arm with the utility knife and also make a small hole on the bear. (See pattern.) Place the brass fastener through both the bear and his arm, so that it can move up and down.
5. Paint the bear using various colors of poster paint.
6. Once the paint dries, prop the bear up with a chair or against a wall so your photo opportunity can begin.
