

Bug Costume



Materials for Antennae:

headband
black pipe cleaners
thick green pipe cleaners
hot glue
2 green pom-poms
pencil

Directions:

1. Wrap black pipe cleaner around headband.
2. Wrap one end of green pipe cleaner around headband for antennae. Curl around a pencil.
3. Hot glue pom-pom onto other end of green pipe cleaner. Repeat for second antennae.

Materials for Wings:

2 pieces of green poster board (12 inches x 18 inches each)
orange and light green construction paper
6 feet of ribbon
hot glue
scissors

Directions:

1. Cut two half-circle wings from the green poster board. They should each be about 16 inches long and have an 8-inch radius.
2. Cut various sizes of circles out of the colored construction paper and hot glue to wings.
3. Overlap the wings slightly, so that it looks like a piece of the circle is missing from the bottom. (See photo.)
4. Cut two holes through the top of both pieces of poster board.
5. Thread the ribbon through the holes so that both ends come out on the underneath side of the wings.
6. To tie on the wings, bring the ribbon over each shoulder, cross the pieces over the "bug's" chest, and tie the ends together in the back.
