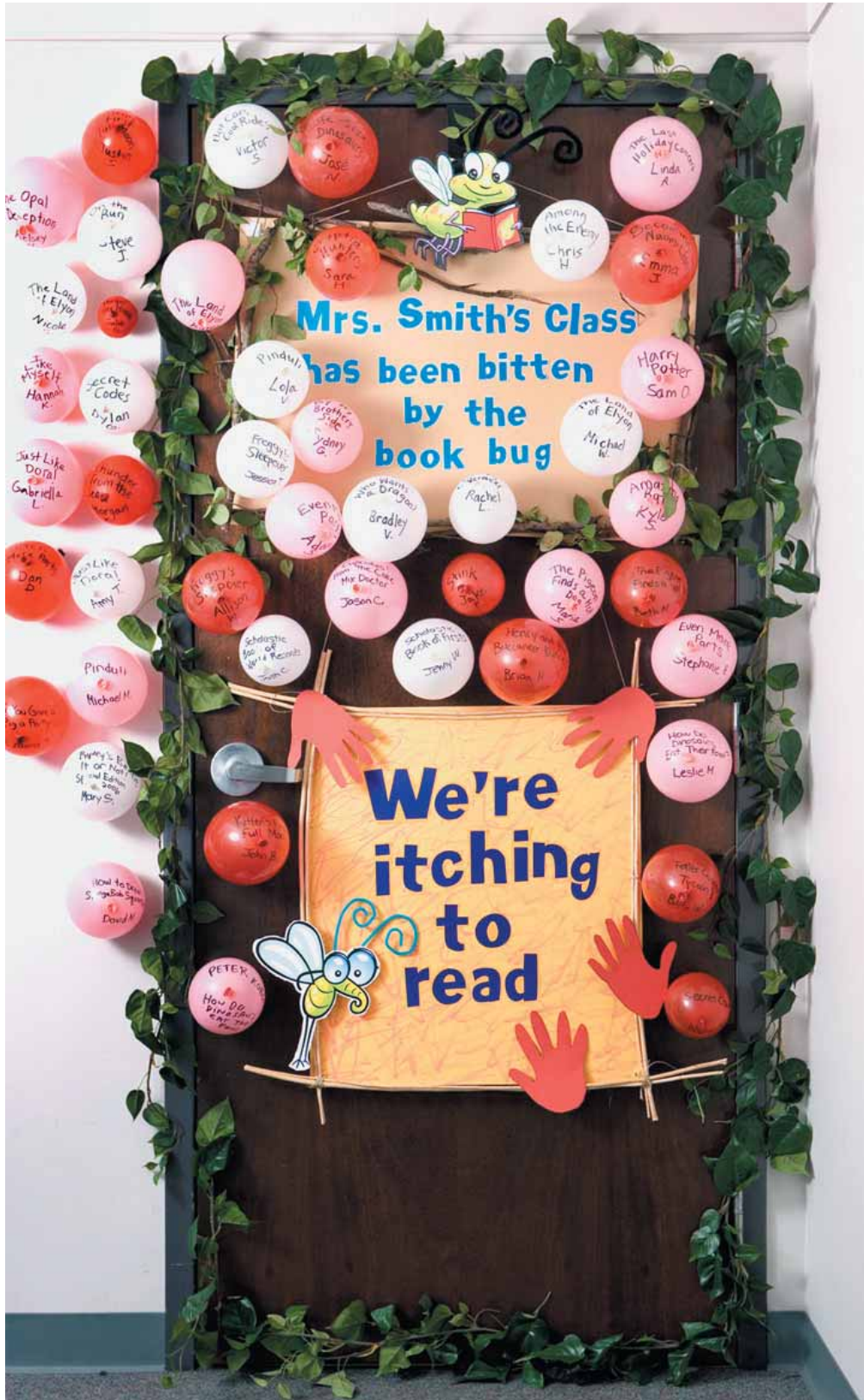


Classroom Door



Materials:

two rectangular pieces of cardboard (size depends on the size of your door)
two smaller pieces of cardboard, about 6 inches x 6 inches
poster paint
hot glue
vines (bought from local craft store)
bugs from logo
white glue
packing tape
balloons
permanent marker
clear tape
two black pipe cleaners
construction paper
twigs

Directions:

1. Paint each rectangular piece of cardboard with a color of your choice.
2. Use paint to write: _____ class has been bitten by the book bug! on one of the pieces of cardboard.
3. Print out the larger bug from the logo and glue onto smaller piece of cardboard.
4. Cut out with utility knife.
5. Hot glue bug onto cardboard sign.
6. Hot glue twigs around border of cardboard sign.
7. On second cardboard sign, use paint to write: We're itching to read.
8. Print out the smaller bug from the logo and glue onto smaller piece of cardboard.
9. Cut out with utility knife.
10. Hot glue pipe cleaner antennae onto bug.
11. Hot glue bug onto cardboard sign.
12. Hot glue twigs around border of sign.
13. Trace your hand four times onto construction paper and cut out.
14. Use hot glue to glue to sign.
15. Attach cardboard signs onto door.
16. Attach fake vines around door using clear tape.
17. Have students write book titles and their names on balloons and use clear tape to attach balloons to door.
