

Directional Sign



Materials:

poster board
wood plank or balsa wood
poster paint
hot glue
nails (optional)
utility knife
scissors
masking tape

Directions:

1. Make pole using regular wood plank. It can be whatever height you want.
2. Paint pole brown if using balsa wood.
3. Cut out various shapes, such as arrows and rectangles, out of poster board.
4. Paint the shapes, let dry, and then paint words on them.
5. Attach shapes to pole with hot glue.
6. Take two small pieces of wood or balsa wood (about 6 inches by 3 inches, but the taller your pole, the bigger the X should be) and make an X out of them, attaching with nails or hot glue.
7. Then attach X to bottom of the pole with nails or hot glue.
8. Take another piece of wood or balsa wood (length depends on height of pole) and hot glue to back of pole, making an easel (see photo).
