

Lantern



Materials:

14 inch. x 3 inch. strip of green construction paper
10 inch x 1 inch strip of green construction paper
3 inch x 1 1/2 inch strip of green construction paper
4 1/4 inch circle out of green construction paper
4 1/2 inch circle out of green construction paper
12 inch x 5 inch strip of clear vellum paper
12 inch x 6 1/2 inch strip of clear vellum paper
black marker
transparent tape

Directions:

1. Cut out a 14 inch (w) x 3 3/4 inch (h) strip of green construction paper. Using a black marker, draw a black line down the middle and at the top of long side of the strip of paper. Tape the two short ends together, forming a ring. This is the base of the lantern.
2. Cut out a 12 inch (w) x 5 inch (h) strip of clear vellum paper. Tape the two short ends together and insert this cylinder into middle of the lantern base. Tape cylinder and base together with a few strips of transparent tape.
3. Cut a 4 1/4 inch circle out of green construction paper. Place circle on top of vellum cylinder and tape with transparent tape.
4. Cut out a 12 inch (w) x 6 1/2 inch (h) strip of clear vellum paper. Tape the two short ends together, forming another cylinder. Place cylinder in the top middle of the 4 1/4 inch circle. Tape cylinder to circle with transparent tape.
5. Cut another 4 1/2 inch circle out of green construction paper. Tape circle to top of the 6 1/2 inch cylinder with transparent tape.
6. Cut out a 10 inch (w) x 1 inch (h) strip of green construction paper. Tape the two short ends together. Place ring in the middle of the 4 1/2 inch circle and tape to the top of it with transparent tape.
7. Cut out a 3 inch (w) x 1 1/2 inch (h) strip of green construction paper. Tape the two short ends together. Place this ring in the middle of the 1 inch tall cylinder and on top of the 4 1/2 inch circle. Tape ring to circle with transparent tape.
8. Tape thin strips of black paper to the outside of lantern with transparent tape, creating a wire effect.
