

# Tree



**Materials:**

concrete column form (found at local hardware store),  
size can vary, depending on size of room  
light brown bulletin board paper  
tape  
brown paint (darker than bulletin board paper)  
green poster board  
green bulletin board paper  
scissors  
glue  
wood to support tree

**Directions:**

1. Crinkle brown bulletin board paper. Uncrinkle and wrap around tube to create "bark." Tape to back of tube. Make sure whole tube is covered.
2. Dab with brown paint to create tree trunk effect. Let dry.
3. For green part of tree, cut a tree shape out of green poster board.
4. Cut a second, but similar, tree shape out of green bulletin board paper and glue to back of first tree cut out.
5. Hot glue tree leaves to top of trunk.
6. Support tree by leaning wood against tree, like an easel.
