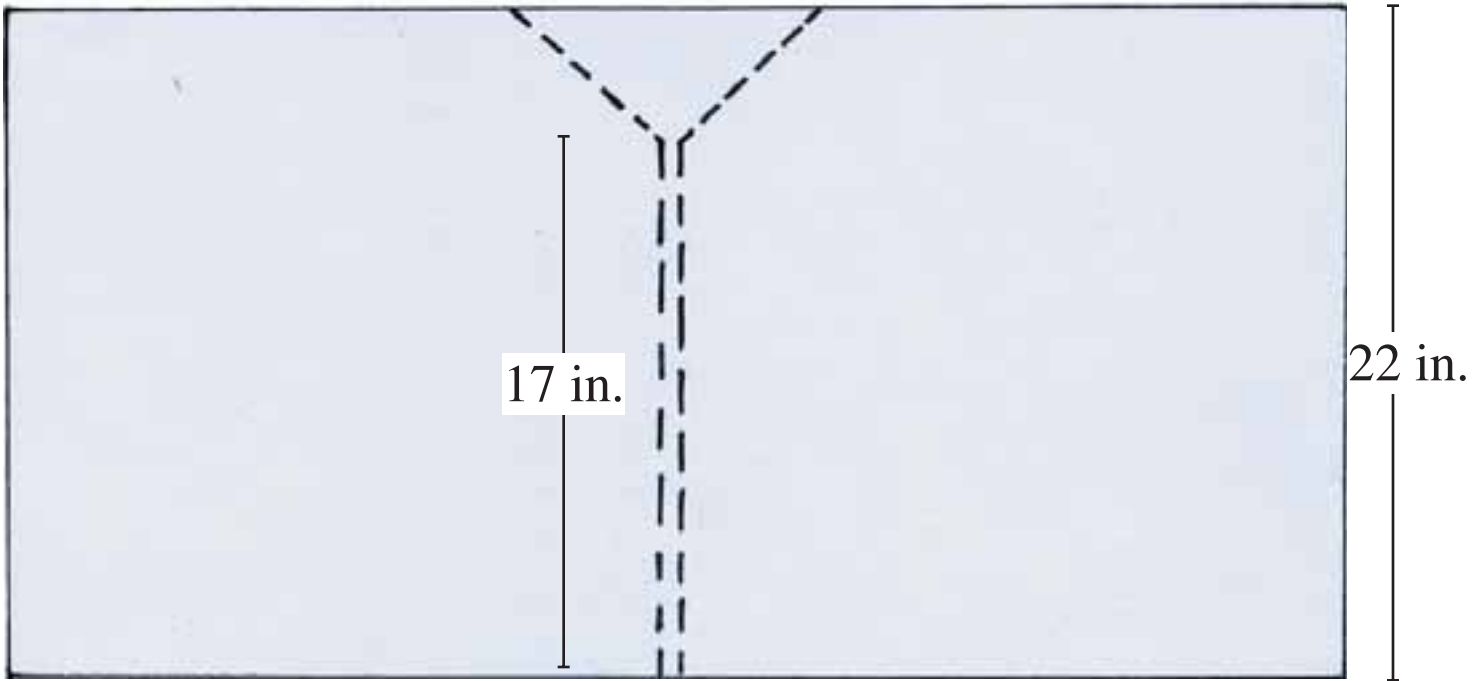

# Princess Costume

## Materials for Headband

tulle, satin, polyester, or material of your choice (6 in. x 24 in.)

hot glue gun

scissors

plastic headband

ribbon

satin roses

pipe cleaners (optional)

felt (optional)

1. Cut two pieces of tulle, satin, polyester, or material of choice into 3 in. (wide) x 24 in. (long) piece.
2. Gather one end of each piece of fabric and hot glue to tips of a plastic headband.
3. Wrap ribbon around plastic headband, securing with hot glue.
4. Glue small satin roses to top of headband.

OR

Wrap large pipe cleaners around headband. Cut small flowers out of felt and glue to top of headband.

## Materials for Cape or Cloak

broadcloth (44 in. x 44 in.)

scissors

hot glue gun

ribbon

1. Fold a 44 in. x 44 in. piece of broadcloth in half.
2. Cut a 17 in. vertical slit up the middle of the top piece of material only.
3. Cut a triangle out at the top of the slit, about 7 in. wide, creating an opening for child's head.
4. Hot glue wide ribbon around cut fabric to give it a finished look.
5. Hot glue additional ribbon near the neck so it can be used to tie a bow and secure cloak in place.
