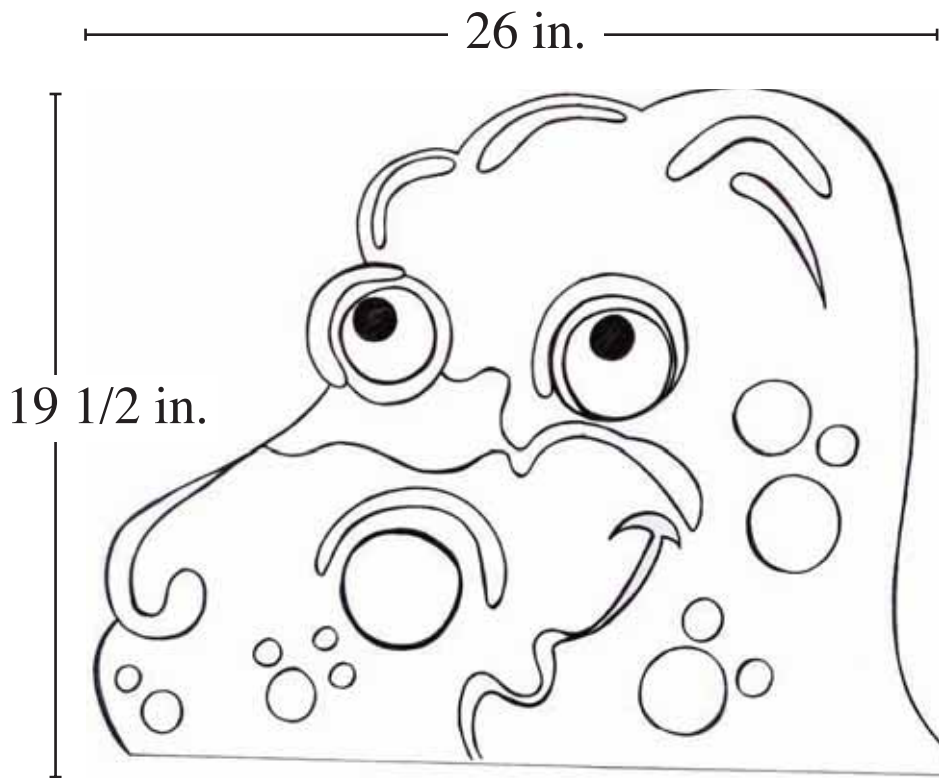

Dragon's Head, Ears, and Spine



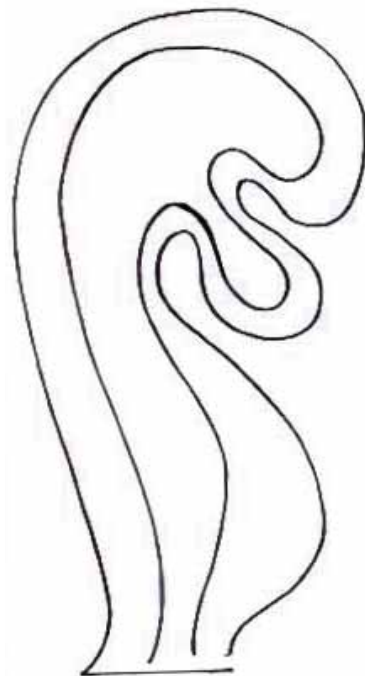
Dragon's Head



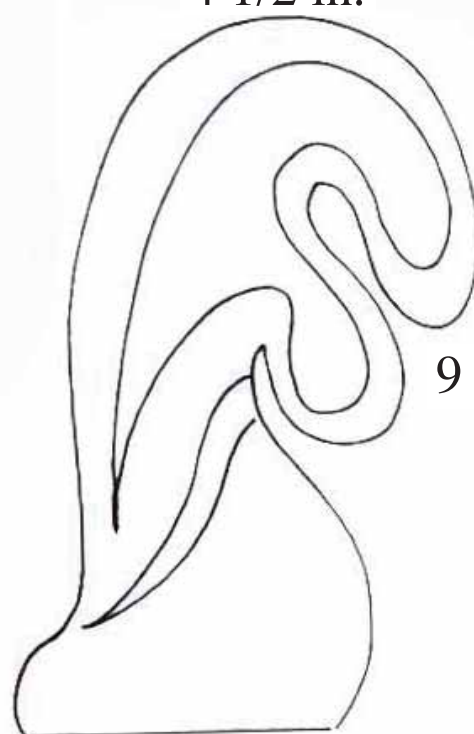
Dragon's Spine

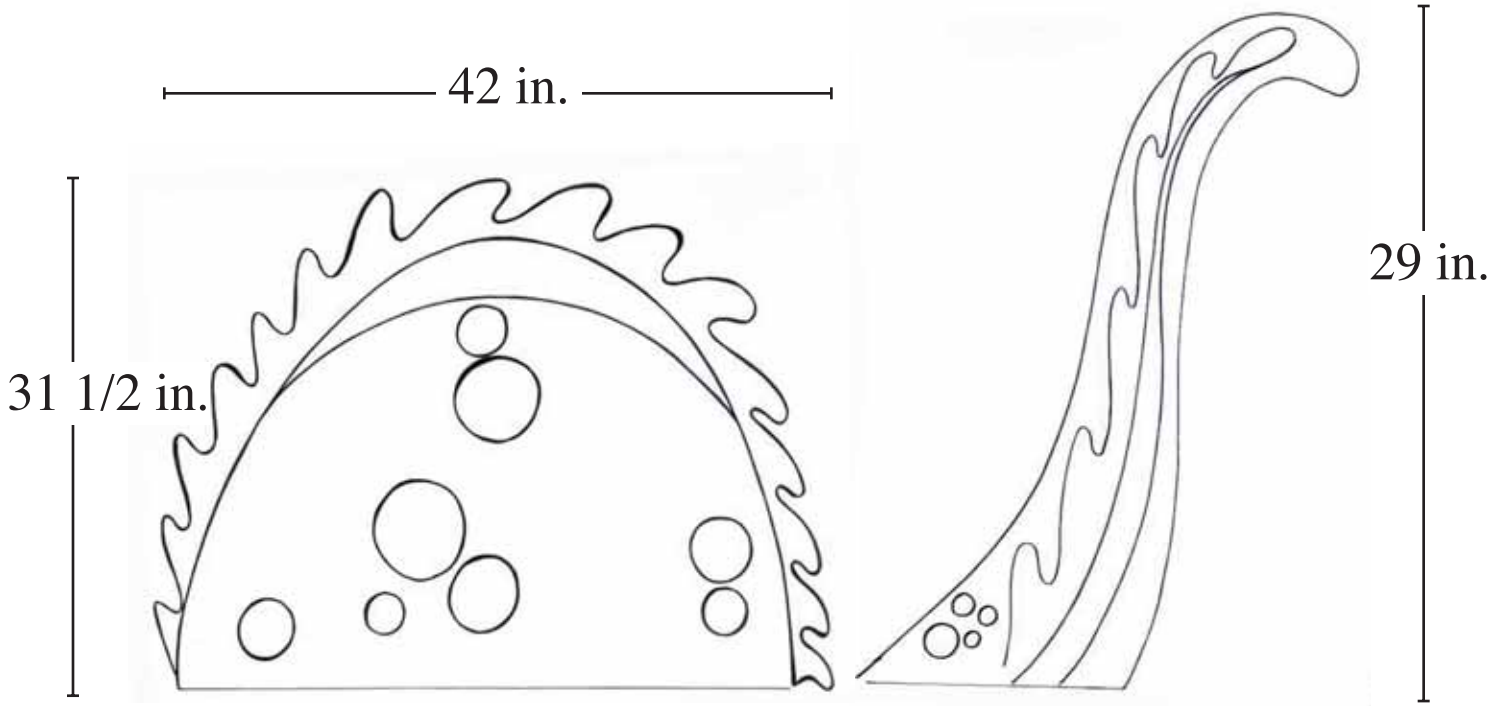


Dragon's Ears



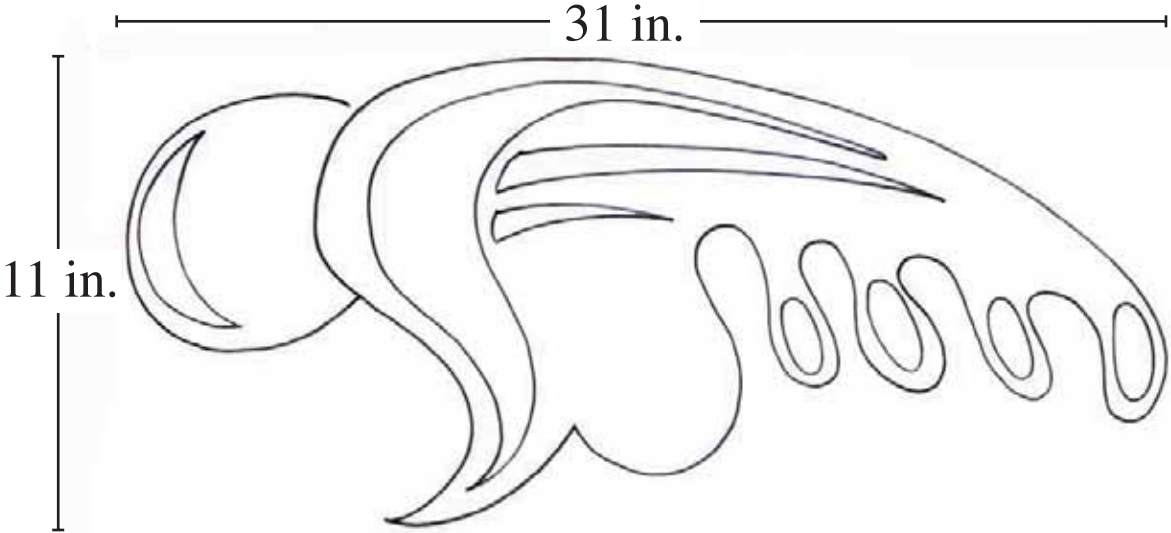

Dragon in Three Sections

Materials

3 sheets of cardboard to use as base (1 - 48 in. x 96 in., 2 - 32 in. x 40 in.)

pencil or pen

scissors

utility knife

various shades of green construction paper

yellow construction paper

black construction paper

hot glue gun (or white glue if you use construction paper instead of foam) and glue sticks

1. Draw pattern on cardboard using pen or pencil.
2. Cut out patterns using utility knife.
3. Glue green construction paper on cardboard dragon and trim off excess.
4. Cut spines out of yellow paper and glue to dragon.
5. Cut wings out of green construction paper and glue to dragon.
6. Use lighter shades of green paper to create accents on dragon. Cut out the accents and glue on dragon.
7. Use black construction paper for dragon's eyes and nose. Glue to dragon.
8. Create a basic triangle easel out of cardboard to make each section of the dragon stand up.
