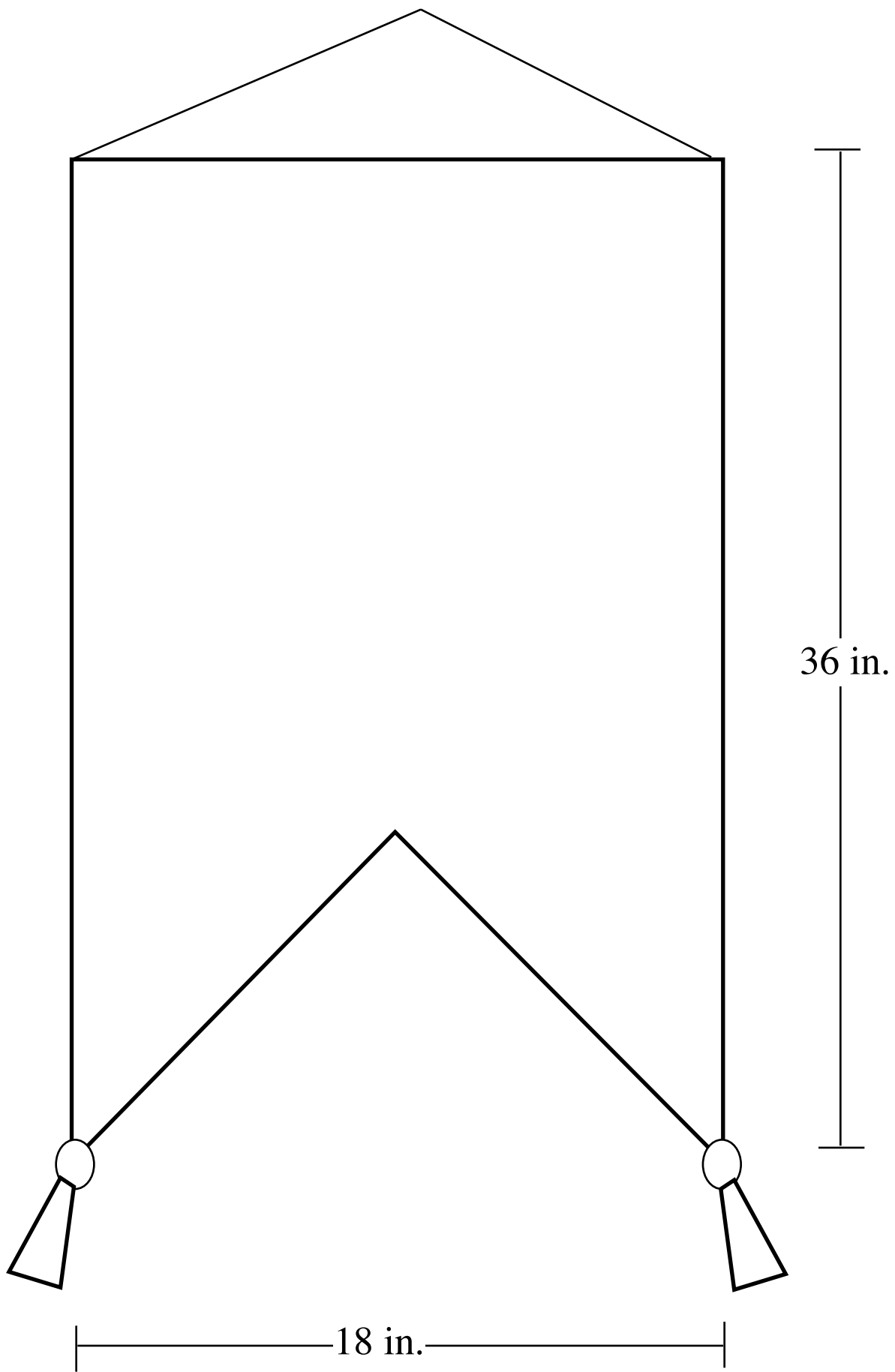


BANNER

Rule!

Banner

Materials for One Banner

2 yds. of yellow broadcloth

1 yd. of white and blue felt

pencil or pen

scissors

iron

¼in. thick wooden dowel, 18 in. long

36½ in. gold string to use to hang banner

fabric glue

hot glue gun and glue sticks

2 gold tassels

needle and thread (or sewing machine)

1. Cut two pieces of broadcloth to 18 in. x 36 in.
2. Cut out a V shape at bottom of both.
3. Sew or fabric glue sides and V together.
4. Turn inside out and press with iron.
5. Flip top over to make seam pocket for dowel, and sew or glue in place. Place dowel through pocket.
6. Sew or glue tassels to bottom corners of banner.
7. Trace letters onto felt and cut them out. The letters are double-layered, with the bottom layer (white) slightly larger than top layer. Glue to banner with fabric glue.
