Read-Aloud Tips:






-  Share the joy of reading with children by playfully making books come alive as you read.
-  Ask open-ended questions such as, "What will happen next?"
-  Pause to allow children to fill in repeated phrases or rhyming words.
-  Connect story events to familiar real-life experiences, people, and places.
-  Introduce new words to help children build their vocabulary.

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Read daily with your child.

Experience and explore print together.

Ask questions and listen carefully.

Discuss—keep conversations going.
