This program shares strategies for finding pertinent information in nonfiction text by scrutinizing text features that all family members will enjoy. Between 50 and 80 percent of all standardized test content students will face will be informational text, and by the sixth grade, more than 50 percent of reading in school is going to be informational text. We need to prepare students for this kind of reading which is expected in both college and in the workplace. Families will learn and practice strategies to help their children be successful at reading and comprehending nonfiction.
