



YOUR LIFE IS AN OPEN BOOK

How to find out anything you want to know in Seven Simple steps

First, think of a question you would like to have answered.

- should I tell him I like him?
- will I ever become a nuclear physicist?
- what does my dog really think about me?

To get the answer:

1. Count the number of letters in your first name. *Laurel = 6*
2. Count the number of letters in your last name. *Anderson = 8*
3. Write them as one number. *68*

Subtract the letter count of your middle name. *Ingrid = 6*
(If you don't have a middle name, skip this step.) $68 - 6 = 62$

4. Concentrating on the question you need answered, pick up any random book and flip to the page with your number.
5. On that page, count word by word to find the one that corresponds to your number.
6. Read the entire sentence containing that word. That's your answer.*



*Understanding the answer may require a little interpretation on your part, of course. It's a message exclusively for you, after all, so its meaning probably won't be obvious to anyone else. If you draw a total blank, try again with a different book.
