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HOW MUCH DO PROUT THE

#1: Kiki: My Stylish Life

What similarities do the Lotus Lane Girls share? What differences make them individuals? For example, how is Kiki similar to Coco? How is Kiki different from Coco?



Why does Miss Melody say Kiki and Mika are on "the same creative page"? Reread Chapter 9 to find clues in the text and in the art.

How does Kiki react when Mika says that Kiki's kimono fashions might look better on Maxi than on Coco and Lulu? Do you think Kiki handled the stuation wel? Why or why not?



How is Kiki's diary similar to and different from other diary-like books you have read?

Write your own diary entries. Use text, and art to include all the events that have happened in the past few days.

#2: Coco: My Delicious Life


What are some of Coco's favorite things?

Create your own charity! Give your charity a name. Write down who it will help, what the volunteers will do, and why it is important to you.




Do you think the Lotus Lane girls should (invite Mika to join their club? Use examples from the book to make your argument.





HOW MUCH DO TOWNOW BOUT






Why doesn't Mika tell the LLGC about Katy's gossip column? Do you agree with her decision? Use examples from the book to support your answer.
