



INFORMATIONAL BOOKS AGE BY AGE

Infants Start babies off with sturdy board books that they can handle and picture books that you can look at together. *My Car, Trains, Boats* or any other title by Byron Barton are excellent choices.

Toddlers There are plenty of nonfiction picture books that are just right for toddlers. Try Seymour Simon's excellent photography books (*Cats, Dogs, or Wild Babies*).

Preschoolers Three- and 4-year-olds often develop specific interests in animals, dinosaurs, knights, and castles. Include nonfiction books and magazines on these subjects in your classroom library.

Kindergartners Help children use a print or CD encyclopedia and other reference books.
