
Create comics with Cat Kid Comic Club, Dog Man, and your favorite Dav Pilkey characters!





SAD


Eyebrows: U-shape


Mouth: Wide, turned down

Eyebrows: Raised, upside-down U-shape Mouth: Turned down, clenched teeth









CREATE YOUR CHARACTER







STORY STARTERS

Make a story for your characters to star in!


- Color the Story Starter Cards. Then cut them out and place them face down in two piles.







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LIGHTS! CAMERA! ACTION!
