

Enlarging grid patterns is so easy that children can do it. Each side of a square equals one inch.

- Enlarge the easiest patterns directly onto a large sheet of any paper. Using a measuring tape, measure and mark all corner points of the pattern on the paper. Then draw the full-size pattern by connecting the points with lines as shown.
- To enlarge a pattern with more details, use a cardboard cutting board with a grid printed on it. Tape a sheet of tracing paper to the full-size grid by marking all corners and then connecting them with lines as shown. Or use a one-inch grid paper.

Stitch zipper on front. Stitch inner leg seams. Turn one leg right side out and push into the other leg. Stitch center seam from zipper end to neck edge. Stitch underarm seams. Stitch sleeves to armholes.
