

## Cape

Enlarging grid patterns is so easy that children can do it. Each side of a square equals one inch.

- Enlarge the easiest patterns directly onto a large sheet of any paper. Using a measuring tape, measure and mark all corner points of the pattern on the paper. Then draw the full-size pattern by connecting the points with lines as shown.
- To enlarge a pattern with more details, use a cardboard cutting board with a grid printed on it. Tape a sheet of tracing paper to the full-size grid by marking all corners and then connecting them with lines as shown. Or use a one-inch grid paper.

## Sewing directions

With right sides together, stitch center back and side seams of fabric and lining separately. Stitch lining to cape, leaving neck edge open. Trim corners, turn right side out, and press. Place interfacing to wrong side of collar. Stitch collar to lining, leaving neck edge open. Trim corners, clip curves, turn right side out, and press. Gather neck edge of the cape and stitch the collar to the cape. Sew ties from leftover fabric and stitch to front edge below collar.
