POEM FORMS

Acrostic Poem—a poem that uses the letters in a topic word to begin each line. Each line should be related to or describe the topic.

If you choose this type of poem, the topic word written out down the side of your poem will be the name of your reptile.

Example:

Green shiny scales

Eats bugs and soft fruit

Can climb trees

Kauai is where it can be found

Oh, how I wish I had a real one!

Shape Poem—a poem that describes an object and is also shaped like the object it describes.

If you choose this type of poem, the one you will write will be in the shape of your reptile, so first lightly draw out the shape of your reptile and then fill it in with the words of your poem.

Example:
