

# Text Features Brainstorming Page

Begin to write down ideas for how you will use these elements of an article to write about yourself using the “Magazine Article Template” worksheet.

## Anatomy of a Magazine

**magazine:** a publication containing articles, stories, pictures, or illustrations

**article:** a piece of writing about a subject or subjects

**heading:** the title of a story or article

**subheading:** a secondary heading to explain article’s subject to reader

**graph or chart:** a visual that shows important locations or data

**illustration:** drawing to explain or complement article’s subject

**caption:** text that appears below a photo or illustration to explain visuals

**bold type:** darkened, heavier text to emphasize or call out information

**italics:** text slanted to the right to emphasize a point in an article

**sidebar:** shorter article that runs alongside main article to explain or offer background

**callout:** an attention-grabbing quote from the article

**footnote:** a comment or note that appears after an article and refers to a statement or other part of the text
