## THE KIDS FLAUNT CONTEST Official Rules

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER OR WIN. A PURCHASE DOES NOT IMPROVE YOUR CHANCES OF WINNING.

**1. HOW TO ENTER.** Go to scholastic.com/flauntit from September 15, 2017, at 12:01 a.m. ET to November 3, 2017, at 11:59 p.m. ET and download the Lesson Plan, the Student Activity Sheet, and the contest entry form. Have your students complete the activity described in the Lesson Plan and Student Activity Sheet and fill out the entry form. Once their parents have signed the entry form (and included an optional photograph) and after the students have completed their essays, the teacher can submit the student entries in one of two ways: by mail to Kids Flaunt Contest, c/o Scholastic Inc., 557 Broadway, Scholastic National Partnerships, New York, NY 10012 or email to flauntit@scholastic.com.
