Web Site or Blog

A good Web site or blog:

- Is a clear and helpful resource on a specific topic
- Uses humor, intelligence, and facts to encourage people to browse longer
- Is updated frequently and at regular, dependable intervals
- Uses graphics to enhance the message, but not to distract viewers
- Is interactive and allows visitors to e-mail or leave comments

Photographs and Videos

Powerful photos and videos:

- Are cropped or edited to focus on the most important elements
- Feature familiar places and people
- Provide visual proof of written or spoken truths
- Don't flash by too quickly

PowerPoint Presentations

Presentation tools such as slideshows:

- Enhance speeches with visual cues and reminders
- Allow statistics to be more clearly understood through the use of graphs and charts
- Don't distract from the spoken message

Newspapers

Great articles and editorials:

- Provide readers with in-depth explanations of important issues
- Reach a wide range of diverse people
- Are often community-focused
