- 4. Gaby is American, but her mother is not, which is why she was gets deported. How does this affect Gaby?
- 5. What helps Gaby's father realize that he is not taking care of her well enough?

- 6. Do you think Gaby's mother makes the right decision to stay in Honduras? Why or why not?
- 7. If you could bring home an animal described in one of Gaby's flyers, which one would you choose? Explain why.
- 8. Gaby asks her aunt to tell her mother, "no matter how far away she is, she's in my heart always." What does Gaby mean by this?
- 9. Would you prefer to be a dog trainer like Alma, a writer like Gaby, or a veterinarian like Dr. V? Explain your choice.
- 10. Why are Jan and Dolores mean to Gaby? How does Gaby finally stand up for herself?
