The teachers were terrified at first. But eventually, with the help of some brave and sensible children, they settled down.



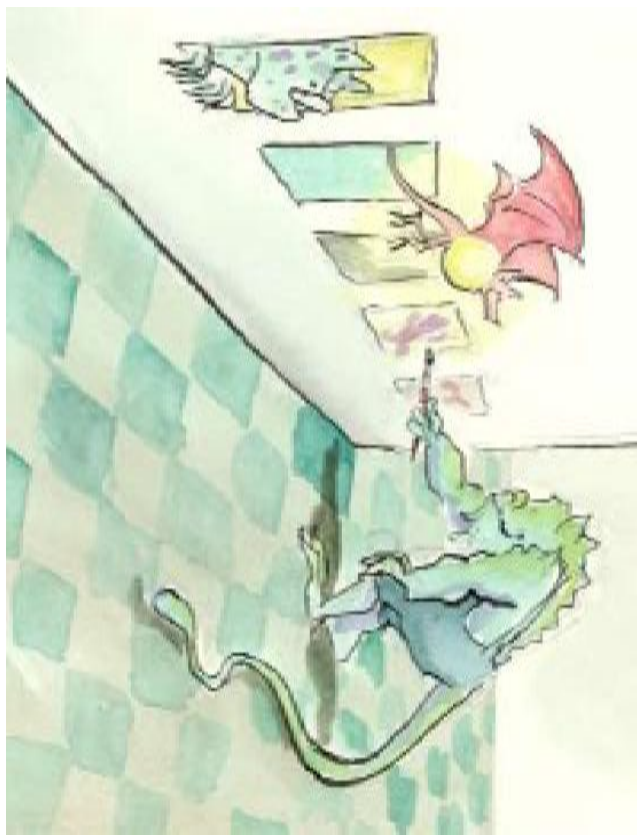
Every morning folks saw just old Mr. Allgunky sweeping off the sidewalks.
