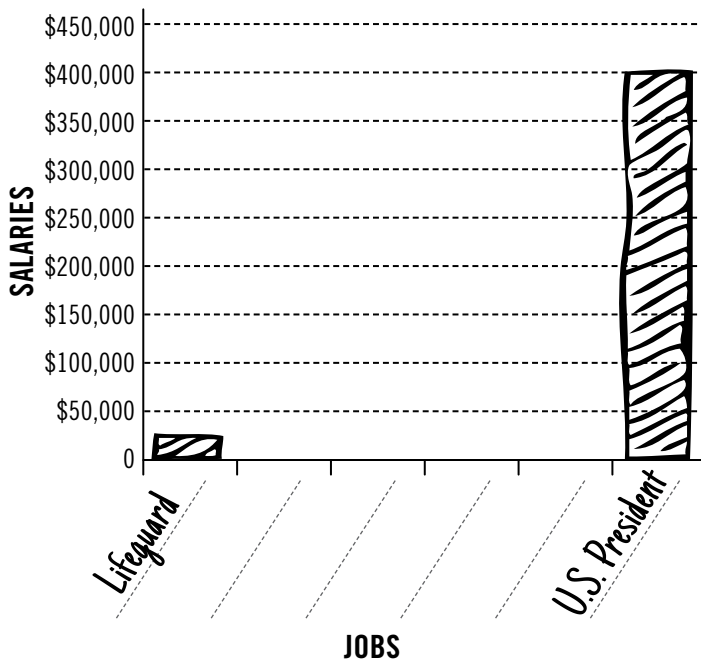
Making Money

- ___ U.S. President \$400,000

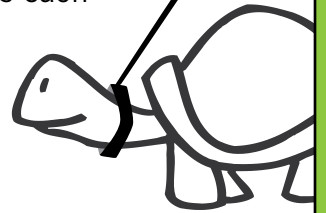
