

HEAD LIGHT LETTER SCRAMBLE

The Portland Head Light in Maine is America's first (and most photographed) lighthouse. Dating back to 1791, it was built to replace the soldiers who stood at the Portland head to warn of British attack during the Revolutionary War. Once lit by whale oil lanterns, the lighthouse today is fully automated and continues to aid sailors navigating along the rocky coast of Maine.

Clue: this is the highest peak on the Atlantic coast
