


FLORIDA: Cocoa Beach Activity

SPACE COAST MOBILE

The area in Florida known as the Space Coast is home to Cape Canaveral and the Kennedy Space Center, where NASA launches all of its manned space flights and many unmanned rockets. WHAT YOU NEED:

- crayons, markers, or colored pencils
- scissors
- clear packing tape for laminating
- yarn or string
- stick or wooden dowel

WHAT YOU DO:

- Color the Space Coast images and cut the shapes out.
- Write a fun fact or two that you learned during your visit to the Space Coast on the back of each picture. Then ask a parent to help you laminate them with clear tape so they are ready to use.
- Punch a hole in each and tie with a length of yarn or string.
- Tie each picture to your stick or dowel so they hang at different lengths.
- Attach a string to the stick and it's ready to hang!
