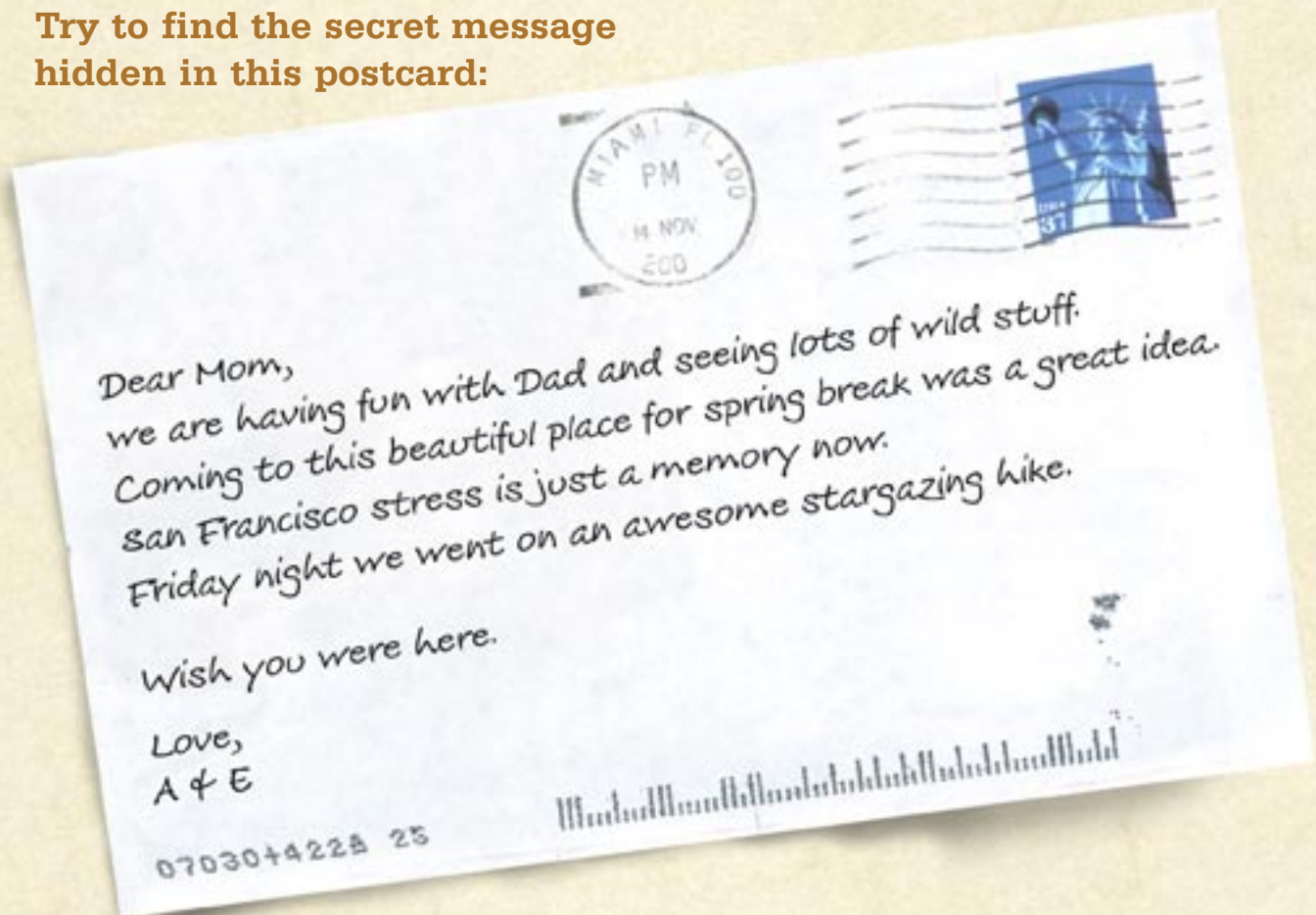

Null code is a form of code writing that spies use when they need to send a message that is likely to be seen by the enemy. Code writing of all kinds can be difficult — it isn't easy to make a letter, email, or postcard sound innocent and natural while hiding important top-secret information. But it's worth the effort, because the code can be hard to break.

Try to find the secret message hidden in this postcard:



The trick of it:

To decipher null code, you eliminate all but the first two words in each line. Put what's left together, and you'll have your secret message.
