So, the next time you're in the neighborhood, check out Blue Moon. It's good food and a good time, too.



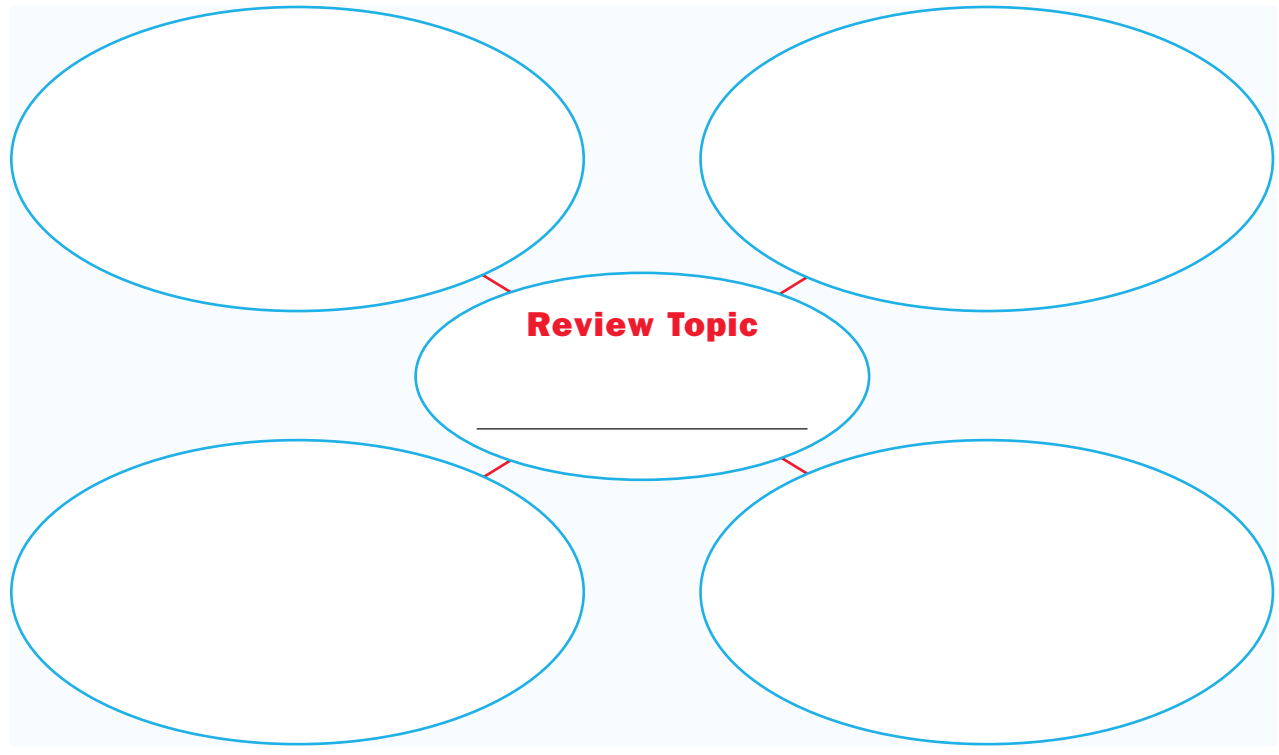
