

Workshop 4: Bullies Beware**Reading 1 Project: Stop All Bullies!**
“Dear Principal”

There’s a problem in your school: bullies! And the principal doesn’t know about it.

Project: Write a letter to the principal. Describe the bullying problem and ask for help.

Procedure**1. Brainstorm.**

List examples of bullying that you have seen at school. Jot down answers to these questions:

- What problems have you seen or experienced?
- Who was hurt? Just the victim? Others?
- Did the bully use words? Force?

2. Write a draft.

Choose one or more examples from the ideas you brainstormed. Then begin your letter to the principal. Here are some ideas to get you started.

- First, tell *why* you are writing.
- Describe an example of the problem. Tell about the effects of the bullying.
- Include details to help your principal understand the problem.
- Explain what you would like the principal to do.

Remember to begin with a greeting. End with a polite closing before signing your name.

3. Present your work.

Write or print a neat final draft. Will you deliver it to your principal?
