Maps contain a variety of elements that show geographical information. Ask a reference librarian for help in locating the maps you need for your research.

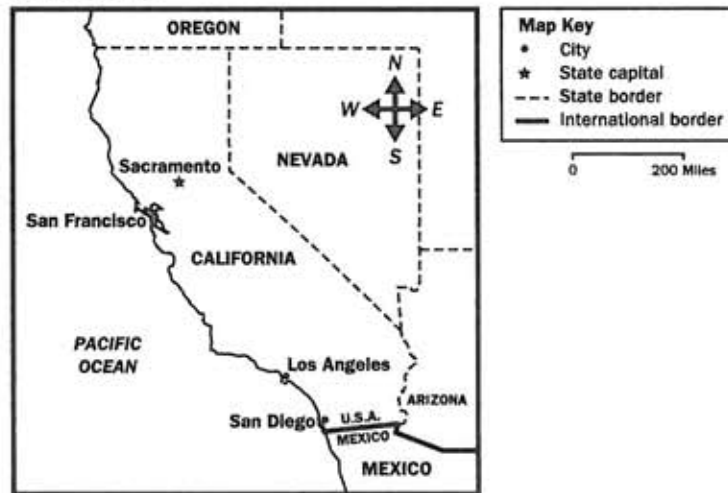
Maps
