- Newspapers:** for up-to-date information

- Nonfiction Books:** for factual information about specific topics
- Electronic Databases:** for CD and DVD encyclopedias, statistical information, and more
- Internet:** for Web sites on almost any topic
- Pamphlets and Brochures:** for summarized information on specific topics by an institution, business, or organization
- People and Experts:** for expertise and opinions in an interview situation
