The root *aud* comes from a Latin word that means “to hear.” Read the definitions below. Then write a word that begins with *aud* to go with each definition.

audition	auditorium
audio	audience

1. people who are gathered to hear something such as music
2. the sound on a TV or other equipment
3. a tryout to hear an actor or singer
4. a large room for listening to concerts, speakers, or plays

Many Latin roots serve as foundations for families of words. For example, the root *vis* comes from a Latin word that means “to see.” The words *vision*, *visit*, and *visible* all relate to seeing.
