# Reporting the News!

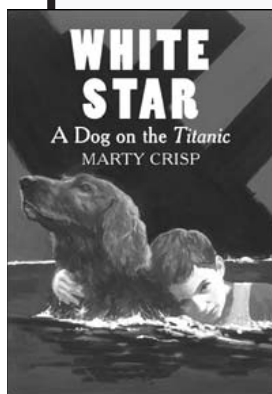
