

She is the creator of *Smile*, a graphic memoir based on her childhood, which was a *New York Times* bestseller and winner of the Will Eisner Award for Best Publication for Teens. Raina also adapted and illustrated the graphic novel versions of Ann M. Martin's *The Baby-sitters Club* books, which were selected for YALSA's Great Graphic Novels for Teens list and *Booklist's* Top 10 Graphic Novels for Youth list. She also coauthored *X-Men: Misfits*, which was a *New York Times* bestseller. Her brand-new graphic novel for Scholastic is titled *Drama*.


