### **EVENT PLANNING TIPS**

#### **Two to Three Weeks Ahead:**

- Advertise the event in your newsletter and on your website.
- Create a Summer Reading display to promote your event.
- Post reminders on your bulletin board and display the event announcement sign (included in the kit) on your library's bulletin board or in your window.

#### **One Week Ahead:**

- Photocopy a supply of the activity sheets that pertain to your event.
- Collect plenty of pencils, crayons, and craft supplies.
- If you wish to have snacks, plan the menu—along with cups, plates, and napkins—available for the event. When considering what to serve, think of ways to tie refreshments in to the theme of your event. For example, choose cheese for a Geronimo Stilton event!
- Plan to have extra help available to ensure that your event runs smoothly.

### **Summer Reading Event Ideas**

**Set the Scene:** To decorate your event space, use the tips outlined in the planner that pertains to your event. Or for a general summer reading feel, decorate with books, a sun, beach balls, and anything else you can think of that suggests summer. Refreshments could include lemonade, as well as traditional snack items.

**Story Corner:** Make sure there are plenty of comfortable places for kids to sit and indulge in their favorite activity: reading! Be sure to have enough copies of the featured books on hand for your event.

#### **Keep It Up:**

Encourage kids to create a reading log so that they can keep track of their reading progress and record their daily reading minutes. They can even join the Scholastic Summer Reading Challenge at [Scholastic.com/SummerReading](http://Scholastic.com/SummerReading).

### SET THE SCENE

Give your event space a Geronimo Stilton feel by creating some **fabumouse** decorations like a book display to showcase Geronimo's books. If you plan to serve refreshments, every mouse

loves a cheese platter. Any orange beverage would make a fine “cheese tea.” Cheese crackers, cheese straws, cheese puffs—you name it!—are also sure to be a hit.

### READ ALOUD

To get attendees in a **marvemouse** mood, begin your event with a reading from your favorite book; any book from your shelves will do. Some great passages include:

- *The Lost Treasure of the Emerald Eye* pp. 1–13
- *The Lost Treasure of the Emerald Eye* pp. 51–67
- *Thea Stilton and the Dragon's Code* pp. 1–27
- *Thea Stilton and the Legend of the Fire Flowers* pp. 1–27 or pp. 1–10 & 37–43

# FUN AND GAMES

## ACTIVITY #1: REPORT-O-RAMA (GROUP)

Geronimo and Thea are some of the best journalists in New Mouse City. One of a reporter's most valuable tools is the interview. For this ice-breaking activity, attendees will have a chance to interview another attendee and then report on that person to the rest of the group.

### PREPARE AHEAD:

- 1) Copy the Report-O-Rama handout for each attendee.
- 2) Have pens/pencils available.

### DURING THE ACTIVITY:

- 1) Have attendees divide into pairs.
- 2) Allow ample time for them to interview each other. Remind them to write down their interviewee's responses.
- 3) Once they are finished, have each pair stand and report their findings to the group to get everyone acquainted.

## ACTIVITY #2: EXTRA! EXTRA! READ ALL ABOUT IT! (GROUP)

Geronimo Stilton's adventures are eye-popping front-page news. During this activity, attendees will create a news article about a great adventure that *they* will write! Contributing one sentence at a time, your attendees will need to put themselves in Geronimo's and Thea's shoes and think on their feet, just like they would during a live adventure.

### PREPARE AHEAD:

- 1) Copy just one Extra! Extra! Read All About It! handout.
- 2) Have a pen/pencil available.

### DURING THE ACTIVITY:

- 1) Gather attendees in a circle.
- 2) Read the article headline on the handout: Breaking News: Alligator-Infested Swamp Hides Secret Hideout! Then, beginning with the attendee to your right, have each person add a sentence to the article, going around the circle two to three times, depending on how many participants are present. When you get to the participant to your left for the last time, remind the group that this will be the culminating sentence of the story.
- 3) Record attendees' sentences as they dictate them.
- 4) When you have finished, reread the article to attendees. You might photocopy it for them to take home, and/or display it in your space.

### **ACTIVITY #3: A GOOD NEWSMOUSE WORD FIND (INDIVIDUAL)**

A good detective knows how to dig through details to find the best news stories. Have attendees put their sleuthing skills to the test as they explore this word find. To up the stakes, have participants race: first to complete it wins!

#### **PREPARE AHEAD:**

- 1) Copy the A Good Newsmouse Word Find handout for each participant.
- 2) Have pens or pencils available.

#### **DURING THE ACTIVITY:**

- 1) Hand out word finds and pens or pencils, and let the sleuthing begin!
- 2) For extra fun, have attendees use ALL the words in the word find to create a run-on sentence chock-full of Newsmouse jargon.

Run-ons might not work at *The Rodent's Gazette* but they sure are fun to come up with! Have attendees share with the rest of the group.

## **ACTIVITY #4: A MOUSETASTIC MYSTERY (INDIVIDUAL)**

Attendees will have fun inventing their own secret treasure map using drawing tools and/or simple craft materials.

### **PREPARE AHEAD:**

- 1) Photocopy one A Mousetastic Mystery handout for each participant.
- 2) Have crayons/markers/colored pencils and scissors available.
- 3) (Optional) Have craft materials for making the topography of their maps 3D (such as craft sand, cotton balls (snow), raffia, artificial grass, twigs, glitter, etc.) and glue available. You might also have a hot glue gun available for yourself to assist participants.

### **DURING THE ACTIVITY:**

- 1) Set up tables so that participants have ample room to work.
- 2) Tell them to choose a specific point on the map to “bury” their treasure.
- 3) Have everyone write three clues that lead to the location of their treasure on the back of his or her map.  
For example:
  - 1) Go to the place where you have breakfast.
  - 2) Turn right and walk three steps.
  - 3) Hop four times, then open the door.
- 4) Encourage participants to draw, color, cut out, and (optional) 3D decorate that location and its surroundings on their map. Remind them to include an “X” to mark the spot where their treasure is buried!
- 5) Allow them to take their projects home, or keep them to display them in your space or window.

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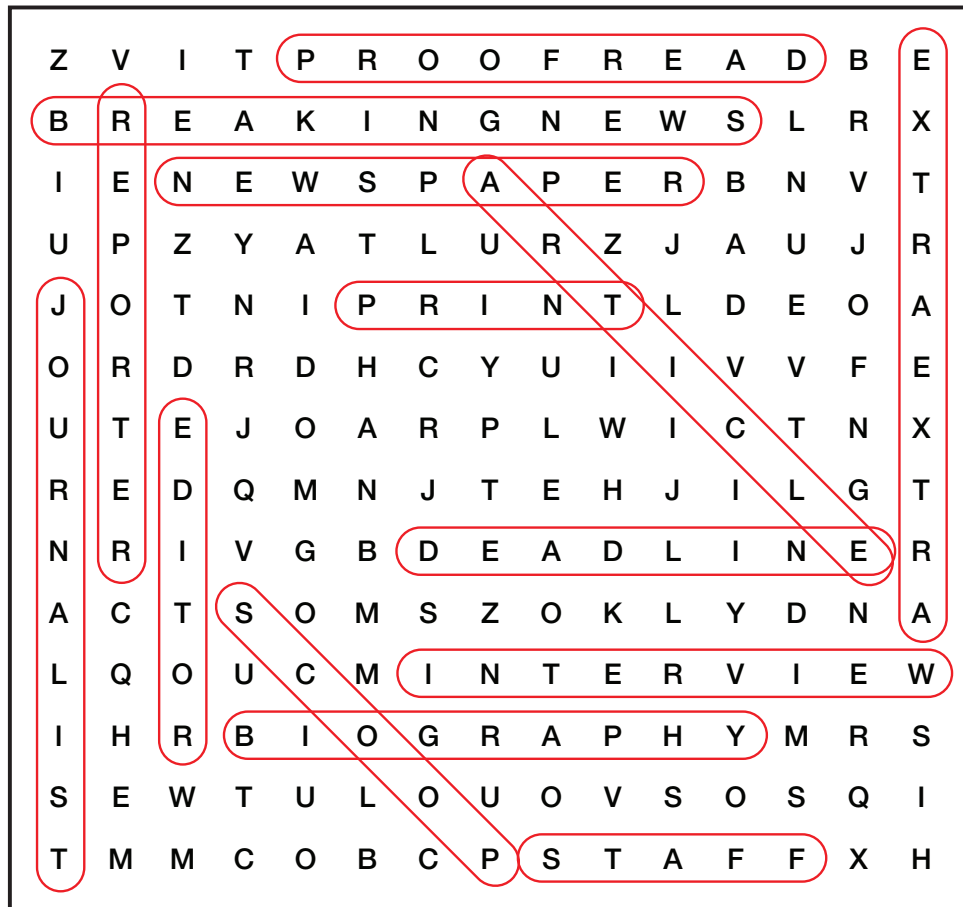

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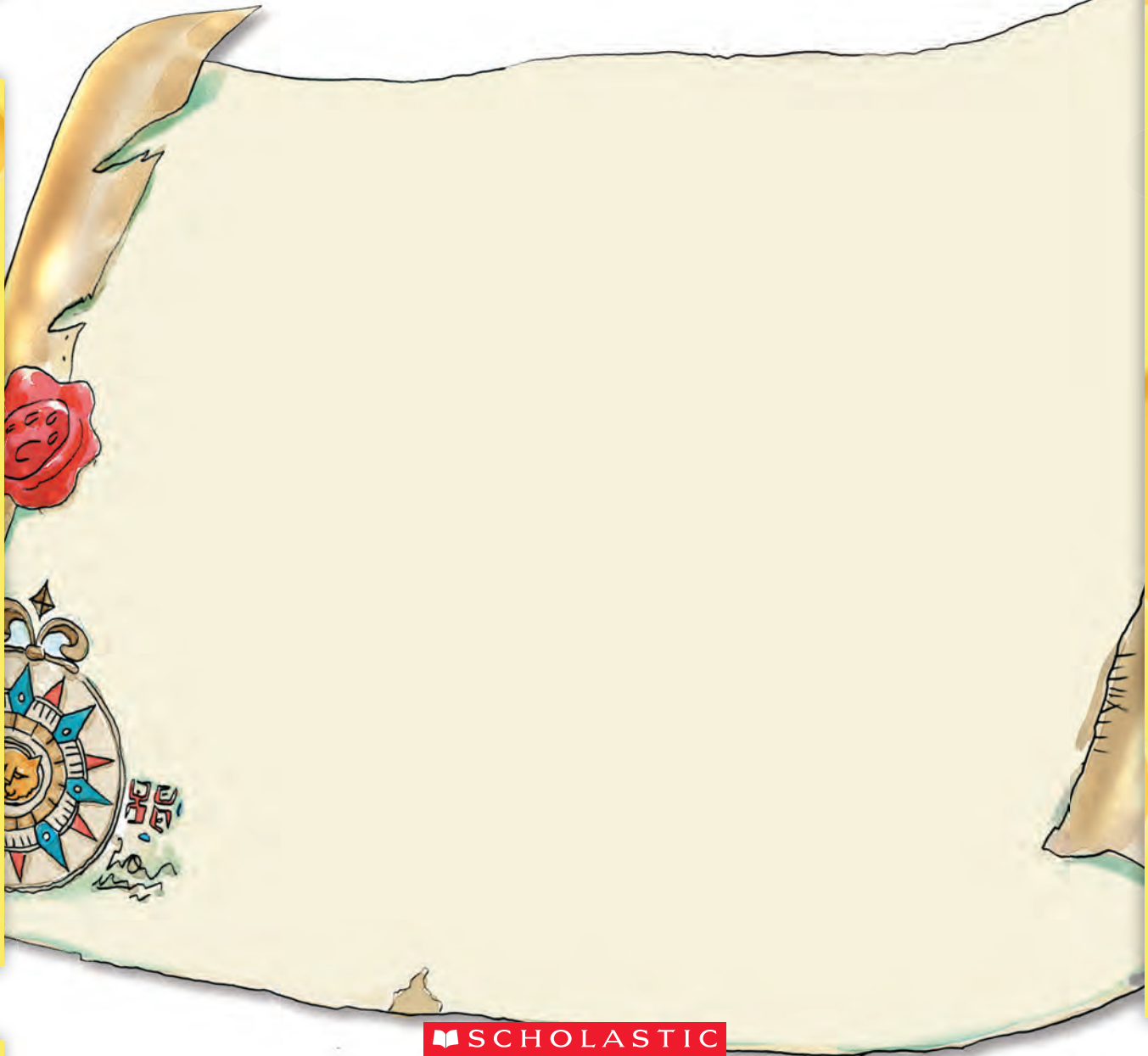

## Set the Scene

Give your event space a Hogwarts feel by creating Golden Snitch ceiling decorations: paint foam craft balls gold, add a feather to each side, and suspend them from the ceiling using clear thread or fishing line. You can also suspend brooms to serve as Nimbus 2000s and hang banners with House names: Hufflepuff, Ravenclaw, Slytherin, and Gryffindor. If you plan to serve refreshments, you can find inspiration from favorite Hogsmeade spots like The Three Broomsticks and Honeydukes. A cream soda or root beer float makes a great stand-in for butterbeer. It might be hard to find Chocolate Frogs and Pepper Imps, so turn up the imagination and create substitutes with things like malt balls and red-hot cinnamon candies.

## Read Aloud

To get attendees in a magical mood, begin your event with a reading from your favorite Harry Potter book. Any book from your shelves will do!





## Fun and Games

Use the following reproducible activities to turn what is sure to be a fun day into a spectacular event!

### Activity #1: Who Have I Transformed Into? (handouts 1A and 1B, group)

In *Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets*, Harry, Ron, and Hermione are convinced that Draco Malfoy is the Heir of Slytherin. To hear him admit this, they drink Polyjuice Potion and pose as Malfoy's friends, Crabbe and Goyle.

For this activity, attendees will imagine that after taking a sip of Polyjuice Potion, they've been transformed into a character from the Harry Potter series!

To find out which character they are supposed to be, attendees will have to ask each other a series of "yes" or "no" questions. This activity can also be used as a simple icebreaker to get kids up, moving around, and talking to one another.

#### Prepare Ahead:

- 1) Print out one copy of the **Who Have I Transformed Into? (1A)** handout and cut out the nametags.
- 2) Photocopy the **Who Have I Transformed Into? (1B)** list of character names for attendees to reference.
- 3) Have tape available.

#### During the Activity:

- 1) Make sure that attendees have space to move around the room.
- 2) Discuss the activity and rules, making sure that everyone understands how to play.
- 3) Read the list of names aloud. If there are more attendees than names on the sheet, use the blank spaces to come up with additional character names as a group.
- 4) Use tape to attach a nametag to each attendee's forehead or back, making sure that no one sees his or her own nametag.

#### Rules:

- 1) The goal is to be the first person to figure out whom he or she has transformed into.
- 2) When you say "go," players will begin to move around the room asking each person they encounter a yes-or-no question (e.g., "Am I a professor?" or "Do I wear glasses?") to help them guess the name on their nametag.
- 3) When players meet, each person should ask only one question and answer only one question before moving on to question another player. If they run out of people to ask before figuring out their name, they may start again.
- 4) The first person to figure out his or her character's name wins the privilege of being the first player in the next group game, or you may choose to award other prizes. Repeat the game as many times as you would like, as time allows.





## Activity #2: More Things That Must Not Be Named

(handouts 2A and 2B, group)

Wizards in the world of Harry Potter will do anything to avoid saying the word “Voldemort” out loud. In this game, each participant will get a card. On each card will be the name of an item from Harry Potter’s world and a list of forbidden words that the participant is not allowed to say in their description of that item.

### Prepare Ahead:

- 1) Photocopy one **More Things That Must Not Be Named (2A)** handout for the host to read to participants.
- 2) Photocopy two **More Things That Must Not Be Named (2B)** handouts. (One is to be cut into cards, and one is for the host to reference during the game.)
- 3) Have a hat or box available.
- 4) Cut out the cards on the **More Things That Must Not Be Named (2B)** handout and place them in the hat or box.

### During the Activity:

- 1) Gather attendees in a circle.
- 2) Have attendees come up one by one and pick a card from the hat or box.
- 3) Have them attempt to describe that word without using any of the other words on the card, while the rest of the group tries to guess the word.
- 4) Use your own copy of **More Things That Must Not Be Named (2B)** handout to follow along and alert them if they use any of the forbidden words.

## Activity #3: King’s Crossword Puzzle

(individual or pairs)

Test fans’ knowledge of *Harry Potter and the Sorcerer’s Stone* with this challenging crossword puzzle. Attendees might find it fun to put their heads together in pairs for this activity.

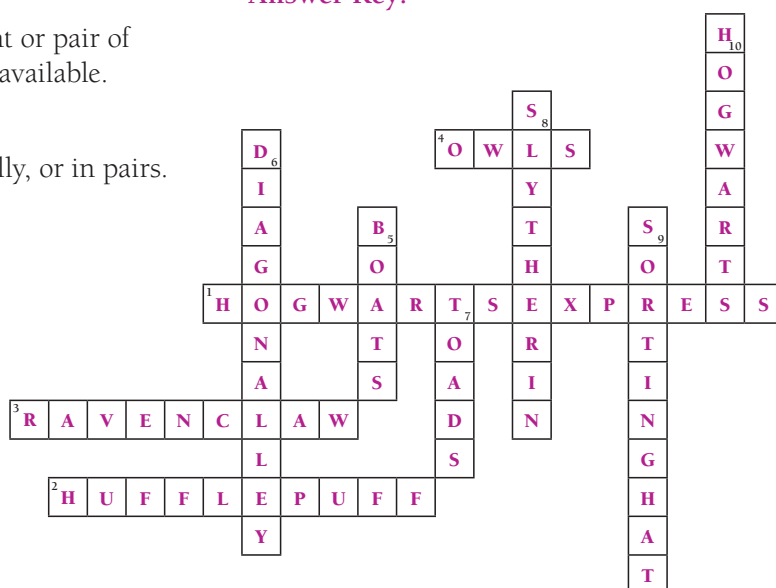
### Prepare Ahead:

## Activity #4: Wand-Making Craft (individual)

Have attendees design their own wands! Encourage them to think of what materials would best match their personalities.

**(Optional)** Then have attendees make their own wands using items like straws, paper-towel tubes, chopsticks, or other similar items. Afterwards, they can take their wands home or display them in your window or event space.

### Prepare Ahead:

- 1) Photocopy one handout per participant.
- 2) (Optional) Collect wand-making supplies:
  - One wand base per participant (such as straws, paper-towel tubes, or other similar items)
  - Glue and/or hot glue gun for you to assist
  - Various decorations like feathers, glitter, pipe cleaners, stickers, etc.

### During the Activity:

- 1) Ask participants to imagine which wand would choose them, and sketch it on the handout.
- 2) (Optional) Distribute craft supplies so participants can build their wands. In *Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone*, Mr. Ollivander explains that each wand gains its power from a magical core, such as a phoenix tail feather, unicorn hair, or dragon heartstring. Encourage participants to find an item with special meaning to them and hide it inside their wand to provide the magical core!

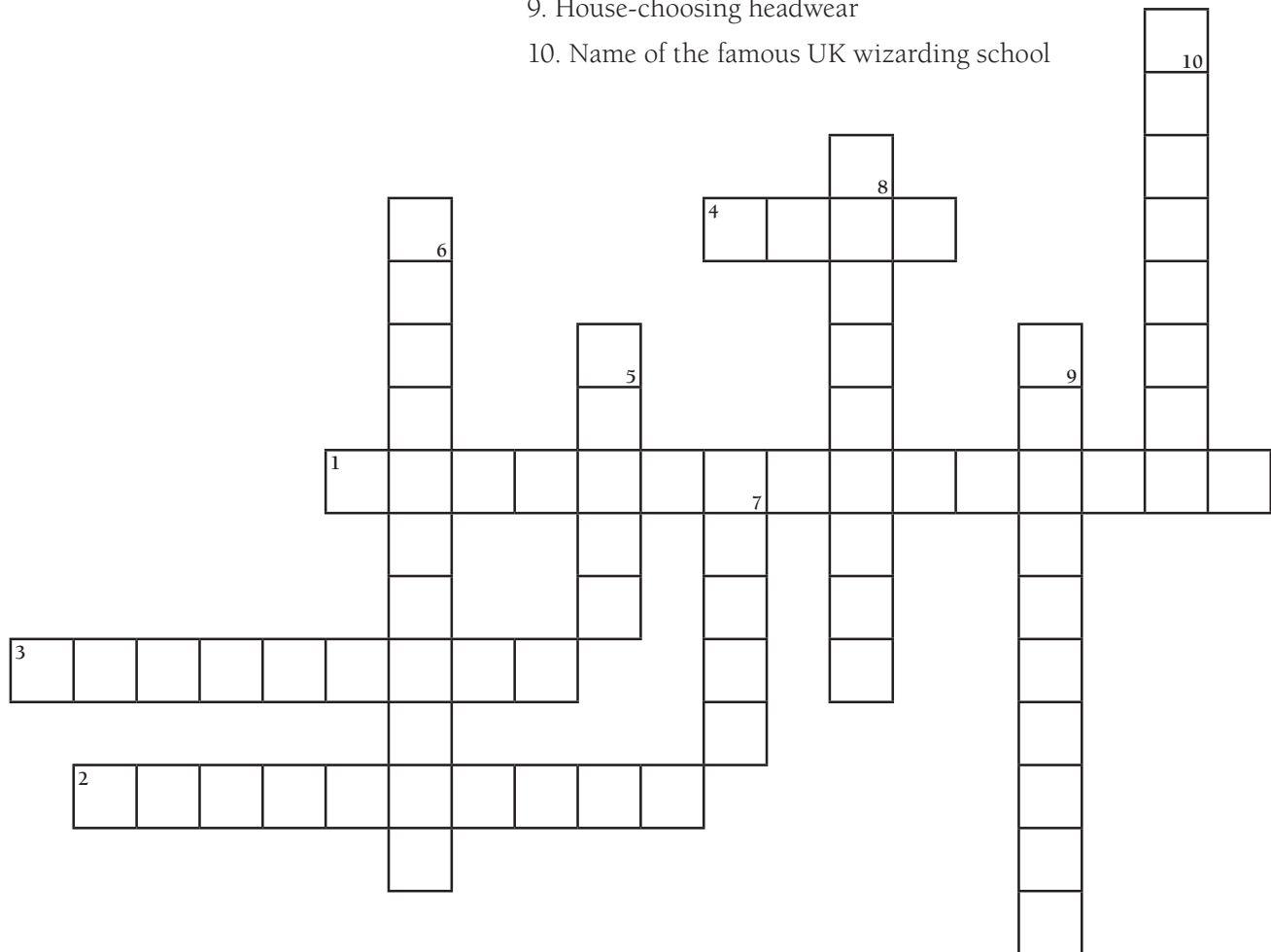

### During the Activity:

- 1) Make sure that attendees have space to move around the room.
- 2) Read the instructions on Professor Poopypants's Name-Change-O-Chart (1A) handout and make sure that everyone understands what to do. Then give attendees time to generate and write their new names on the nametags, and cut the nametags out. Provide tape for them to attach the nametags to their shirts.
- 3) Read the instructions on Professor Poopypants's Name-Change-O-Game (1B) handout, make sure that everyone understands the rules, then let the fun begin!

### Rules:

#### Professor Poopypants's Name-Change-O-Chart (1A)

Following the instructions on the handout (1A), each participant should use the letters of their first and last name to generate his or her new three-part name.

#### Professor Poopypants's Name-Change-O-Game (1B)

- 1) Following the instructions on the handout (1B), each participant should write their new name on the nametag provided, cut it out, and proudly display it by attaching it to their shirts.
- 2) Using the "My Super-Amazing List of Names I Defeated" section of the handout, players—with papers and pens/pencils in hand—will circulate and introduce themselves by their new names to battle it out in a round of rock-paper-scissors.
- 3) The goal is to be the first person to "defeat" five of the other players.
- 4) Round winners get to write down the name of the person they defeated on their (1B) pages.
- 5) The first person to "defeat" five other players wins superhero status (i.e., the privilege of his/her name being used as the catalyst for the next activity) or you may choose to hand out prizes instead.



## **ACTIVITY #2: SUPERHERO RECIPE** (group)

If there's one thing George and Harold are good at, it's imaginative character creation. In this activity, the group will have a chance to flesh out a super-duper superhero, one puzzle piece at a time.

### **Prepare Ahead:**

- 1) Photocopy one Superhero Recipe handout per participant. Have four extra copies available for the group recorder.
- 2) Have pens/pencils available.
- 3) Have a timer available. (optional)

### **During the Activity:**

- 1) Distribute handouts and explain the activity.
- 2) As a group, choose a name for your superhero, or use one of the names created in the last activity.
- 3) Have attendees divide into four groups and assign one of the puzzle pieces on the handout to each group. Ask one person from each group to volunteer to make sure the group's ideas are written down and agreed upon.
- 4) Set a time limit of around five minutes.
- 5) When time is up, gather attendees back together and have volunteers from each group read their work. Encourage attendees to fill in the missing puzzle pieces as they read aloud, or to save their sheets to finish on their own.

## **ACTIVITY #3: GEORGE AND HAROLD'S COLLEGE O' ART FLIP-O-RAMA** (individual or pairs)

Captain Underpants author and illustrator, Dav Pilkey, is a master of his craft. This activity gives your participants a peek into the creative process behind the books and a chance to try their hand at illustration.

### **Prepare Ahead:**

- 1) Make copies of both pages of the George and Harold's College O' Art Flip-O-Rama handout (one per participant/pair of participants).
- 2) Have pens/pencils and blank paper available for each participant.

### **During the Activity:**

This activity can be done individually or in pairs.

## **ACTIVITY #4: THE SUPA WORD SEARCH** (individual or pairs)

George and Harold have traveled through time and encountered words from every imaginable era. This activity challenges participants to use their superhero eyesight to hunt for those words in a fun paper puzzler.

### **Prepare Ahead:**

- 1) Make copies of The Supa Word Search handout (one per participant or pairs of participants).
- 2) Have pens/pencils available.
- 3) Have a timer available. (optional)

### **During the Activity:**

- 1) Distribute handouts and explain the activity.
- 2) Assist attendees (and encourage them to assist each other) as needed.
- 3) Optional: Set the timer and have participants "race" to find the words. Whoever finds the most words by the time the timer is finished wins!
