<b>Inside Upper-Right page</b> Picture of play's set.	All information is present and a detailed picture is shown.	Most information is present. Picture is adequate, but lacks detail.	Some information is present. Picture is inadequate or missing.
<b>Inside Lower-Right page</b> Description of a character.	Detailed description of a character, including character's role and point of view (antagonist, protagonist, main character, minor character, etc.)	Adequate description of character. Includes character's role and/or point of view.	Missing descriptive details. Does not include character's role and/or point of view.
