

## **Rubric for Family Story**

The highest possible score is 12. The student should strive to include all the points written below in his/her presentation.

Oral Presentation (6 points possible)	<ol> <li>Spoke in a voice loud enough to be heard</li> <li>Made eye contact with the audience</li> <li>Didn't obstruct face with papers or the project</li> <li>Kept visual aides still so audience could focus on them</li> <li>Kept body movements to a minimum (no wiggles)</li> <li>Kept information organized</li> </ol>
Project Content (6 points possible)	<ol> <li>Kept information to one appropriate family story</li> <li>Told story in sequence</li> <li>Able to cite references (who told the story)</li> <li>Able to answer reasonable questions from the audience</li> <li>Picked a story that would appeal to the audience</li> <li>Included much information about the topic</li> </ol>
