7. We're the long hairs that grow on the snouts of rodents. We're _____.

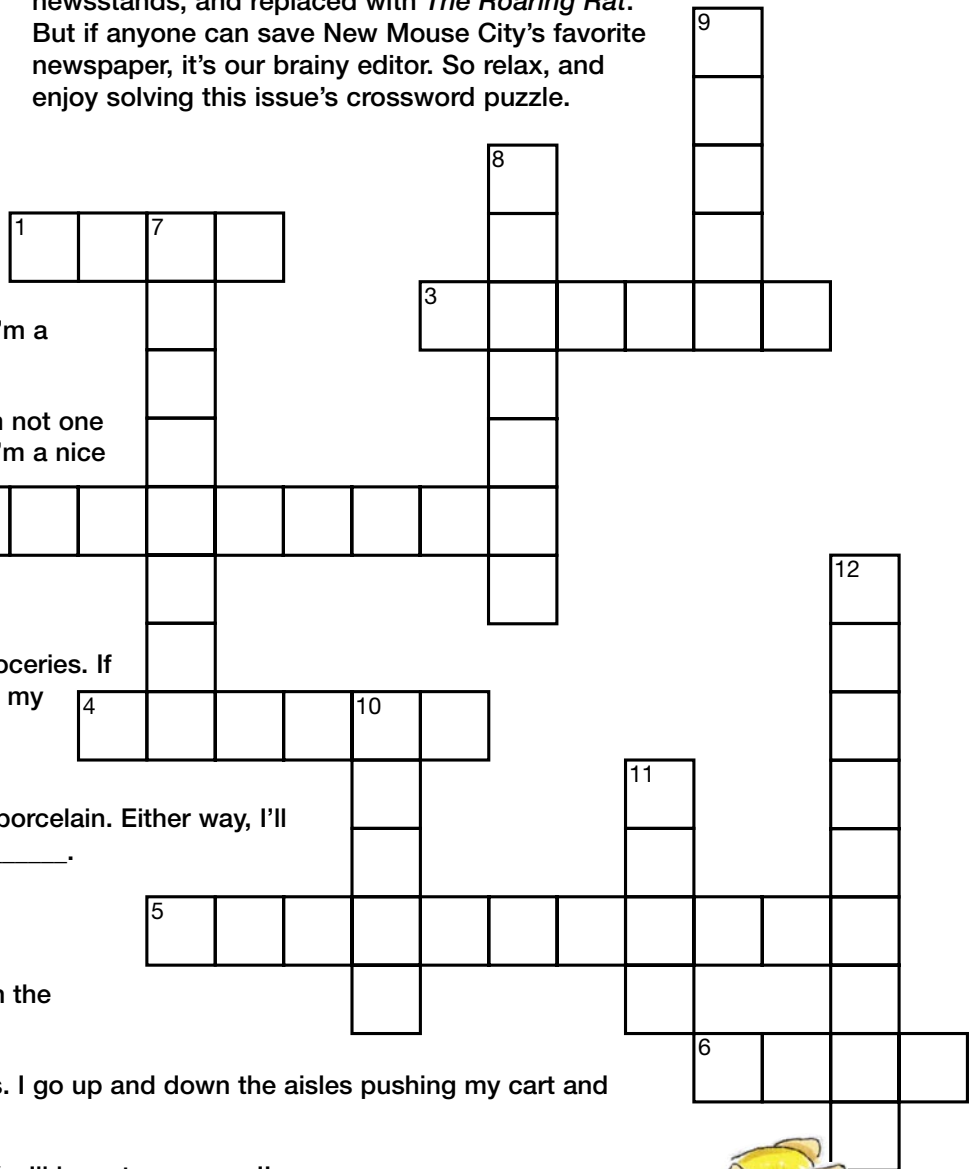
8. I'm a person looking for bargains. I go up and down the aisles pushing my cart and reading labels. I'm a _____.
