The contests entries on behalf of the School must be composed by a student currently attending the School who is a legal resident of the United States and is enrolled in grades K-5. Entries may only be submitted electronically or via mail by teachers and/or parents on behalf of the student. To enter the Be a Backyard Superhero Contest (the "Contest"), the eligible student must create an original picture using the character cutouts. Then the student will write a story about how he/ she is a Backyard Superhero working to combat the environmental villains (Carbon Creep, Dust Demon, Dr. Rhuoff, and Heat Freak) alongside TurfMutt & the Outdoor Powers and save living landscapes everywhere. For students in grades K-2 the story should be 25–50 words and for students in grades 3-5 the story should be 100–150 words. Start: 12:01 a.m. ET on 2/5/16, deadline: 11:59 p.m. ET on 4/6/16.
