

Evaluation Guide

How to evaluate handwriting with this guide:

- **I.** Write the sentences from the Evaluation Guide on the board.
- 2. Students practice writing the selection on ruled paper.
- **3.** Students use their best handwriting to write the selection again.
- **4.** Compare students' writing with the examples on the Evaluation Guide, using the Keys to Legibility. The evaluation should be done as follows:

Excellent—All keys are acceptable. **Good**—At least three keys are acceptable. **Average**—At least two keys are acceptable.

Fair—Only one or two keys are acceptable. **Poor**—Only one or none of the keys is acceptable.

5. Repeat the evaluation procedure at least once each grading period.
