

# **Evaluation Guide**

#### How to evaluate handwriting with this guide:

- **I.** Write the sentences from the Evaluation Guide on the board.
- 2. Students practice writing the selection on ruled
- **3.** Students use their best handwriting to write the selection again.
- 4. Compare students' writing with the examples on the Evaluation Guide, using the Keys to Legibility. The evaluation should be done as follows:

**Excellent**—All keys are acceptable.

**Good**—At least three keys are acceptable.

**Average**—At least two keys are acceptable.

**Fair**—Only one or two keys are acceptable. **Poor**—Only one or none of the keys is acceptable.

5. Repeat the evaluation procedure at least once each grading period.
