21st CENTURY COMMUNITY LEARNING CENTERS (21st CCLC)

OVERVIEW

Supports programs that offer a broad array of enrichment activities outside of the regular school day that can complement a regular academic program.

Supports literacy and other educational services for the families of participating children.

USE OF FUNDS

- 1. Before school, after school, and summer school programs to advance student achievement
- 2. Activities based on scientific research and proven practices, as appropriate
- 3. Academic improvement and enrichment required
- 4. Mathematics and Science
- 5. Programs for LEP students
- 6. Telecommunications and technology
- 7. Parental involvement and family literacy
- 8. Assistance for drop-out and at-risk students to improve their academic achievement
- 9. Arts and music
- 10. Entrepreneurial education programs
- 11. Tutoring and mentoring
- Drug and violence prevention, counseling, and character education

KEY POINTS

- 21st CCLC is a state competition in which eligible applicants apply to their State Education Agency.
- Schools may use Title I, Part A funds with 21st
 CCLC funds to upgrade the entire educational program of a school.
- 21st CCLC funds may be used for professional development.
