## Title II, Part D—Enhancing Education Through Technology (Formula Funds)

### OVERVIEW

Goal is to support student academic achievement through the use of technology and high-quality professional development focused on integrating curriculum with technology to improve instruction.

Formula funds distributed based upon the percentage of Economically Disadvantaged students.

### USE OF FUNDS

- Technology to improve student achievement
- Support for professional development across all core academic subjects, that have the following characteristics:
  - ⓪ Grounded in scientifically based research
  - ⓪ Increase knowledge of academic subject area
  - ⓪ Integrated into school-wide and district-wide improvement plans
  - ⓪ Equip teachers and principals with skills to help students meet state standards
  - ⓪ Advance understanding of effective instructional strategies
  - ⓪ High quality, sustained, intensive, and classroom-focused professional development
  - ⓪ Produce demonstrable and measurable effect on student achievement
  - ⓪ Promote effective use of technology
  - ⓪ Assist teachers in how to use assessment data to guide instruction
