Title II, Part D—Enhancing Education Through Technology (Formula Funds)

OVERVIEW

Goal is to support student academic achievement through the use of technology and high-quality professional development focused on integrating curriculum with technology to improve instruction.

Formula funds distributed based upon the percentage of Economically Disadvantaged students.

USE OF FUNDS

- Technology to improve student achievement
- Support for professional development across all core academic subjects, that have the following characteristics:
 - ω Grounded in scientifically based research
 - ω Increase knowledge of academic subject area
 - Integrated into school-wide and district-wide improvement plans
 - Equip teachers and principals with skills to help students meet state standards
 - Advance understanding of effective instructional strategies
 - ω High quality, sustained, intensive, and classroomfocused professional development
 - Φ Produce demonstrable and measurable effect on student achievement
 - ω Promote effective use of technology
 - ω Assist teachers in how to use assessment data to guide instruction

KEY POINTS

- Title II, Part D supports high-quality professional development activities by requiring that at least 25% of funds received by districts be used for high-quality professional development in the integration of technology into instruction.
- Title II, Part D funds may be transferred into Title I, Part A funds. For specific state requirements for the transferability of these funds, please contact your State Education Agency.
