### Title I, Part A—Improving Basic Programs

#### **OVERVIEW**

Goal is to improve the teaching and learning of children in high-poverty schools to enable those children to meet challenging State academic content and performance

standards.

Formula funds distributed based upon the percentage of Economically Disadvantaged students or Poverty Level

#### **USE OF FUNDS**

- Extra instruction in reading and mathematics, science, and computers
- Special preschool, after-school, and summer school programs to extend and reinforce the regular school curriculum
- Activities that scientifically based research suggests will be most effective in helping all students meet State academic and performance standards
- Activities to ensure high quality teachers
- School improvement efforts that utilize effective practice based on scientific research
- Programs proven effective at raising student achievement
- Additional assistance to schools identified for improvement, corrective action, or restructuring
- Supplemental education services for children in failing schools
- Financial rewards to schools and teachers for narrowing achievement gaps or exceeding AYP requirements

#### **KEY POINTS**

- Instructional programs and practices, including professional development, must be based on scientific research and aligned to state standards and assessments.
- Accountability is based on Adequate Yearly
   Progress (AYP) target goals. Schools not meeting
   state-identified goals are classified as "In Need of Improvement."
- Schools in school improvement status for two or more years must use 5-15% of their Title
   I, Part A funds to provide supplemental educational services.
