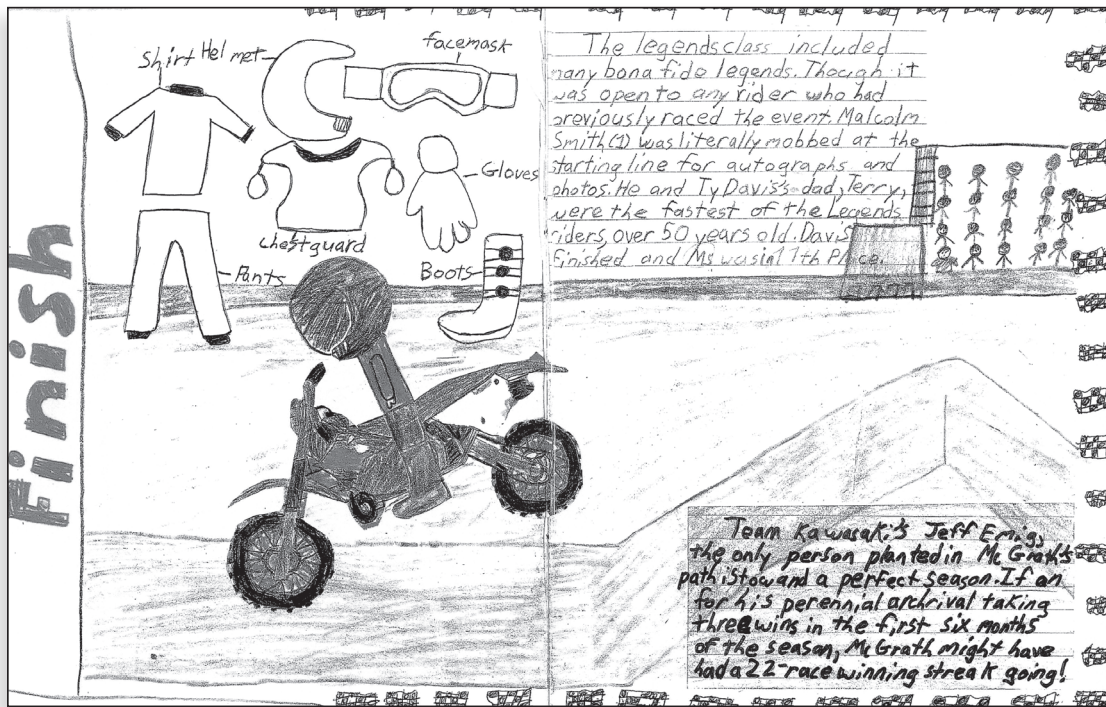


Motocross
